**Homework:** Weekly homework will be assigned and turned in. Some portion of the homework will be graded.

**Exams:** Exam questions will be based on class discussions, readings, and homework. All or some portion of the exam may be take home.

**Attendance:** Attendance is required. Class participation will be an essential part of this course. Students' final grades in the class go down if they miss more than three classes. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING SAID IN CLASS, AND THIS MAY INCLUDE CHANGES TO THE SYLLABUS (an extra exam might be added or the dates might be changed, for example), so if you do have to miss class be certain that you find out what happened in class that day.
